

Dr. Chiu's Student Instruction Rating Survey Report (2004 – 2021)

Rutgers University Student Instruction Rating Survey (SIRS) is conducted at the end of each semester (before 2019: paper survey, after 2019: online survey after). Ten questions are asked about the overall quality of the class. These ten questions are:

1. The instructor was prepared for class and presented the material in an organized manner.
2. The instructor responded effectively to student comments and questions.
3. The instructor generated interest in the course material.
4. The instructor had a positive attitude toward assisting all students in understanding course material.
5. The instructor assigned grades fairly.
6. The instructional methods encouraged student learning.
7. I learned a great deal in this course.
8. I had a strong prior interest in the subject matter and wanted to take this course.
9. I rate the teaching effectiveness of the instructor as (Poor to Excellent).
10. I rate the overall quality of the course as (Poor to Excellent).

The response for each question is categorized from “Strongly Disagree” (1 point) to “Strongly Agree” (5 point); a five-point scale.
